THE MINIMUM WAGES ACT, CHAP. 88:04

ORDER

Made by the Minister under section 3 of the Minimum Wages Act and subject to negative resolution of Parliament

THE MINIMUM WAGES (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2023

- This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Amendment) Citation Order, 2023.
 - 2. This Order comes into effect on the 1st day of January, 2024.

Commencement

3. The Minimum Wages Order, 2014 is amended-

L.N. No. 402

- (a) in clause 2, by deleting the words "seventeen dollars and amended fifty cents" wherever they occur and substituting the words "twenty dollars and fifty cents"; and
- (b) by deleting the First Schedule and substituting the following Schedule:

"FIRST SCHEDULE

(Clause 2)

MINIMUM WAGES FOR ALL WORKERS

Daily Rated (8 hour day) Weekly Rated (40 hour week) Monthly Rated (40 hour week) x 52 weeks \div 12 months = 173.3334 hours \$3,553.33.".
